

Water Polo Ball Release

The ball release is used for the start of play of water polo matches.

Retained on the half distance line, the ball is put into play when the ball release is submerged by pulling the rope from the side of the pool, allowing for fair and accurate starts every time.

At the start of play as the swimmers approach the ball, the ring is pulled under water and the ball released.




