



Uni Pre-FER Iron and Growth for suckling piglets

What is Uni Pre-FER?

Uni Pre-FER is a dietetic, iron-based supplement feed, containing easily absorbable and digestible energy and iron sources, essential oils, butyric acid, and vitamins.

Uni Pre-FER is used as iron supply and growth booster in the early stages of the farrowing pens, whereby piglets are trained for early and increased feed intake. Uni Pre-FER is specially developed for automatic allocation via Unifeeder.

Uni Pre-FER is supplied in 15 kg sacks.
(enough for about 430 piglets)

Focus on iron supplement

There is focus on achieving an appropriate haemoglobin level relatively quickly after birth, as the innate iron depot is depleted after a few days.

The need for iron increases with increased growth, and in order to avoid iron deficiency, the piglets must have extra supplements until their needs are met through feed intake.

The piglets must have a sufficient haemoglobin level before weaning, as it is crucial, especially for the immune system and the blood's ability to carry oxygen around the body (growth).

Haemoglobin levels of piglets should be checked regularly (1-2 times per year).

Advantages of Uni Pre-FER

Dosage and administration

Dosage (14 piglets per litter): Every piglet litter is allocated 500g Uni Pre-FER in all, via Unifeeder (35 grams per piglet). The amount is fed automatically 39 times over the set period (typically the first 8-10 days after birth).

Before emptying the Unifeeder completely for Uni Pre-FER, it is replenished with high-quality pre-starters so that the transition to continued automatic allocation takes place without pause or delay in acclimatisation.

It is recommended that the Unifeeder distributes on a steel feed plate developed for this purpose.

Rapidly growing piglets can be supplemented accordingly with: Combi-FER
